If you lived in Kosovo before and you temporarily reside outside Kosovo now, you can vote only by mail.

There is no need to go to Voter Services Centers this year.

This year all can be done by mail.

Apply for the ballot now and decide later to vote or not.

VOTERS WHO REGISTERED IN PREVIOUS ELECTIONS MUST:

• Send the application form accompanied by a photocopy of an official Serbian, Montenegrin or foreign photo ID (ID card, passport, driver's license).

If your voter details (name, address) have changed, then you can amend them by filling in the same form.

Return your forms as soon as possible. Make sure we receive them BEFORE AUGUST 11.

The application form includes detailed instructions how to fill in and proceed with your form, list of acceptable documents proving your eligibility criteria and also the return address for mailing the form.

NEW REGISTRANTS:

- Fill in and send the application form;
- Send a photocopy of official photo ID (Serbian, Montenegrin or foreign ID card, passport, driver's license).
- You must be at least 18 years of age on Election Day, October 23, 2004;
- You must be either civil registered and provide copies of your UNMIK ID card or UNMIK travel document, or fulfill the civil registry criteria and provide copies of documents showing this;
- Attach a copy of a documents proving you lived in Kosovo on or after
 January 1, 1998: utility bills, apartment forms, documents displaying your name and address in Kosovo.
